Dear Families/Caregivers:

Congratulations! Your scholar will participate in the Middle School Loop Program at Haverhill High School for the 2022-2023 school year. The program will begin on **Wednesday, September 7, 2022**. All classes begin at 7:25am each morning.

To get to Haverhill High School each morning, scholars can take a bus or can be dropped off. Your scholar should board the high school bus that is closest to your home to bring them to the high school in the morning. Bus route information will be provided as soon as it is available. Families can also drive scholars to the high school school each day utilizing the student drop-off lane on campus. After class has ended, they will be transported by school bus to their respective middle school for the start of their regular school day.

Upon arrival at the high school on September 7th, staff will direct all scholars to the Auditorium. There they will be greeted by their teachers and Haverhill High School administrators and escorted to their classrooms. After their first day, scholars should report directly to their class upon arrival at the high school. During the first week of the program, our teachers will assist our scholars to ensure that they are connected to their bus at the end of class.

Scholars are expected to attend their class each day that school is in session, meet all course requirements, and complete all course assignments. Scholars are also expected to follow all rules and regulations while in the building. Upon successful completion of their course(s), scholars will receive a final grade with high school credit. Scholars in full-year classes will earn one credit. Scholars in a semester-based course will earn 0.5 credits for each class taken.
